NOTE: The dates we have given, may be changed as a response to unforeseen circumstances and health restrictions. In the event that NSW Health restrictions prevent CPAC from presenting a physical exhibition all together, CPAC reserves the right to document and publish submitted artworks in an online presentation in consultation with LAS. You may be contacted to advise of any safety procedures that have been put in place.

ELIGIBILITY and HOW TO ENTER

1. All entrants must be financial members of Liverpool Art Society Inc.

Membership forms are available on the LAS website: www.liverpoolartsociety.com

2. Adult entrants must be 18 years of age or over at the closing date of registration. (5 pm, Monday 13th September 2021).

3. Youth categories are open to Year 12 secondary students and younger.

4. Entrants to the Casula Powerhouse Scholarship Prize or the Liverpool City Council Overall Winner prize must have had 12 months continuous membership at the close of registration, 5pm, Monday 13th September 2021.

- previous winners of the Scholarship Prize will not be eligible for this prize again for the next five (5) annual LAS Exhibitions.

5. Artists may submit a maximum of two (2) artworks only. Each of these artworks needs to be submitted on SEPARATE online entry forms.

6. Artworks entered must comply with size & other requirements:

(Read Full Terms & Conditions - available with the Entry form.)

- The perimeter of paintings and other 2D works must not exceed 600cm (including the frame). Sculptures/3D works to have an area of no more than 1 metre cubed. A maximum of 3 minutes is permitted for digital works and must be submitted in MP4/H264 format on a USB.
- The artwork must be the original unaided work of the artist; must have been produced in the last 2 years and must not have been exhibited in any previous LAS exhibition.
- Make sure your name and title of work are on back of artwork where possible. Labels with the artwork details from your entry forms, will be provided by CPAC and attached to each artwork upon delivery to CPAC.
- Artworks must be DRY. Works to be installed on walls must have D-rings or another suitable hanging system.

- It is the responsibility of all entrants to obtain their own insurance cover against loss, destruction, damage and/or consequential loss (including but not limited to natural disasters, catastrophes, and the like) in relation to their

7. The following persons, and their immediate families, are ineligible to enter the PRIZES, but may choose to exhibit/display their work only:

- 2021 Liverpool Art Society Annual exhibition competition judge & immediate family;
- current Liverpool City Councillors & current Council employees & immediate families.

8. Directors and Management/Board/Committee Members of sponsor organisations, staff of the Office of Anne Stanley, Federal Member for Werriwa and staff of the Office of Melanie Gibbons (and their immediate families) **are not eligible to be considered for the prizes they sponsor.** This condition does not extend to Liverpool Art Society or Liverpool Historical Society members who are eligible for all prizes they nominate as long as they meet the outlined conditions for entry.

9. Pay Entry Fee by direct deposit, cheque or cash to Liverpool Art Society Inc:

10. Entry Forms:

- are on-line and accessible directly through the Casula Powerhouse website. LAS website should also have a link.
- paper forms will be available from CPAC front desk
- you can attend the Help Day at CPAC (see Key dates above) if you require assistance with the form.

What you need to complete the on-line LAS Annual Exhibition Form:

- A reference for your exhibition entry fee (date paid, bank reference, or cheque number is acceptable) Pay Entry Fee separately (see Table above)
- Your contact details
- Your ABN (if you have one)
- Your artwork details including: Title, year made, materials/medium, height, width and depth, duration (for digital works in MP4/H264 format) and artwork price.
- An image of your FINISHED artwork to upload to the form (image optional).
- **If you are entering the History or Werriwa Prize, you will also need a statement/explanation ready to type or copy and paste into the form.**
- Remember, you can scroll down at any time to 'preview' the next questions
- Entrants should read the full Terms and Conditions

PRIZES IN THE LAS 24TH ANNUAL EXHIBITION 2021:

These 2 new prizes both focus on our local area - see more information about them and their sponsors below.

Also, if you have not thought about entering the Liverpool History or Werriwa Prizes before, they are well worth thinking about.

The History Prize is open to all Youth as well as Adults. We have included some additional information on Page 5, about these 2 prizes, to help with ideas and where to locate information.

THE COMPLETE LIST OF PRIZES:

\$5,000 (acquisitive) Liverpool City Council Overall Winner Prize - an artwork from any Adult category - you must nominate to be considered for this prize. (see Eligibility Page 1, Point 4.)

\$1,500 Casula Powerhouse Scholarship Prize - an artwork from any Adult category - you must nominate to be considered for this prize. (see Eligibility Page 1, Point 4.)

\$1,500 (acquisitive) John Mula Memorial Prize

An artwork from any Adult category, but it must in some way be, **representative of Liverpool and surrounding areas.**

This one-off prize is sponsored by Rotary Clubs of Liverpool, Liverpool Greenway & Liverpool West. The winning work will be auctioned by the 3 Rotary Clubs mentioned above, to raise money to support charitable works. **You must nominate to be considered for this acquisitive prize** - the amount paid to the winner is \$1,500, even if the winning work has a higher sale price.

\$750 Masterton Prize for Innovation - an artwork chosen from any Adult category. Sponsored by Masterton

\$500 CBA (Moorebank) Prize for Technical Excellence - an artwork chosen from any Adult category. Sponsored by Commonwealth Bank (Moorebank Branch)

\$500 Westfield (Liverpool) First prize for History of Liverpool

\$100 City of Liverpool & District Historical Society Second Prize for History of Liverpool

Both of these history prizes (above) are **open to YOUTH and ADULT entries from any category.** Work must relate to Liverpool's history or heritage and be accompanied by a short written explanation of the significance of their work to Liverpool's history or heritage. **(see final page for inspiration!)**

1st Prize winner will receive a \$500 Westfield Gift Voucher which is valid for 3 years. Sponsored by Westfield (Liverpool),

2nd Prize winner will receive \$100 Sponsored by City of Liverpool & District Historical Society.

\$500 Werriwa Art Prize

Open to entries from any adult category. The work must relate to the Werriwa electorate (past or present) and be accompanied by a short written explanation of how the work reflects the electorate. **It is NOT acquisitive, but to be considered for this prize you must agree that an image of the winning work can be used on the Christmas Card** for the Office of Anne Stanley, Federal Member for Werriwa. Have you considered entering a work in the History and/or Werriwa Prizes, in our Annual Exhibition?

These prizes are NOT acquisitive. They each focus on our local area – your work is naturally still eligible for Category Prizes, and you can still also choose to be considered for Overall Winner Prize or Scholarship Prize (as long as you fill the other requirements for those). You might even think of something that would also be suitable for the \$1,500 (acquisitive) John Mula Memorial Prize as well!

Youth members are also eligible for the History Prizes (but not Werriwa or John Mula Memorial Prizes).

HISTORY PRIZES (1ST \$500 and 2ND \$100)

Open to Adults & Youth

If you enter the History Prize, then your work **must** relate to **Liverpool's History** and you must provide a STATEMENT explaining how it relates.

If you're stuck for ideas consider – People, Places/Objects/Buildings or Events from Liverpool's earlier or more recent Past. It could be a portrait, landscape, still life, or genre work etcetera in any medium.

WERRIWA PRIZE \$500

Open to Adults only

An image of the winning work will appear on the Electorates Christmas card.

For this prize, your work must **relate to Werriwa electorate** (past or present).

You must supply a STATEMENT explaining how your work relates to Werriwa.

Where is Werriwa? Use internet to discover the area/suburbs currently included in the Werriwa Electorate, (from Badgerys Creek and Bringelly in the West to Heckenberg & Casula in the East; from Cecil Park in the North to Denham Court & Macquarie Fields in the South).

For Ideas...Consider - Historical Buildings; Landscapes; Local Identities such as past Politicians; Flora & Fauna.
